Around The World With Barnaby Bear

During Year 1 and Year 2 your child has the opportunity to learn about our world and the features of some of the countries with Barnaby Bear. These lessons are on a Wednesday afternoon and each year group will explore two countries a term. Each child has a special "passport" folder in which they do their work and they collect stickers for every country they visit. The folder can then be taken home at the end of Year 2.

I thought it would be helpful for you to have a list of the key vocabulary that is used in these lessons and to draw your attention to the Barnaby Bear notice board in the library which will display the current country being taught.

If you are taking your child on holiday or on a day trip you can always ask the class teacher for baby Barnaby Bear so that your child can have their picture taken with the bear and bring it to school for our notice board.

Finally I always encourage the children to do their own research into the country we are learning about or to bring in any relevant souvenir or postcard. If your child is able to this it would be helpful if they could say a few words about any object or some facts from the research they have done.
