Physical

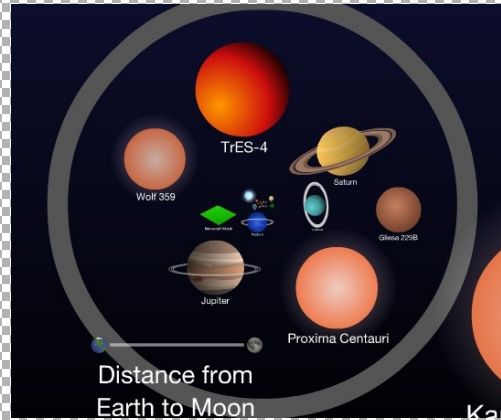
Strengthening core body muscles using high apparatus and ropes.

Mrs Maddox sessions focusing on songs from around the world and playing different percussion instruments

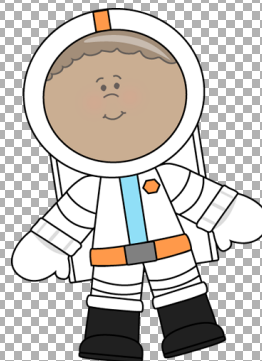
Perform in our Christmas presentation
