School re-opens on Monday 17th April at 8:45am.

## Change to the school day

In <u>April 2023</u> when we come back to school after the Easter break, our school day will start 10 minutes earlier. Your child's classroom door will open at **8:45** and we expect all children to be in classrooms by **8:50** for the morning register. The school day will end at 3:10pm- this will not change in April.

#### September 2023

The Government require schools to offer 32.5 hours a week from September 2023, and to achieve this we need to open a few minutes earlier and close a few minutes later each day. From **September 2023** our school day will be as follows: In the morning doors will open at 8:40 and close at 8:50 for the register. Gates will be closed and locked at 8:50, ten minutes earlier than they are now.



In September 2023 all children will come out of school at 3:15pm, 5 minutes later than they do now. We realise that this will mean parents meeting older children from St Michael's need a prompt finish every day, in order to be at the junior school for 3:20pm.

#### **SATs information**

We always hold a short meeting for parents and carers with children in Yr2 to explain the end of Key Stage 1 assessments that are completed during May. The meeting lasts 30-40 mins and the content will be the same at each session. You do not need to book for this and children can accompany you if they are happy to sit quietly with a book or some drawing. The meetings will be on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May at 2:30pm and 5:30pm.





## **Celebrating the Coronation**


