Printing—use paint and ink to create different prints

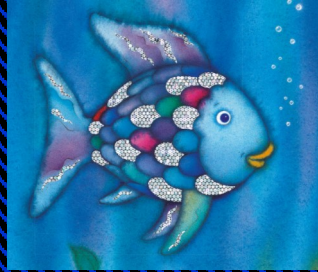
Create rubbings using wax crayons.

Develop pouring, cutting and grating skills at the snack table.

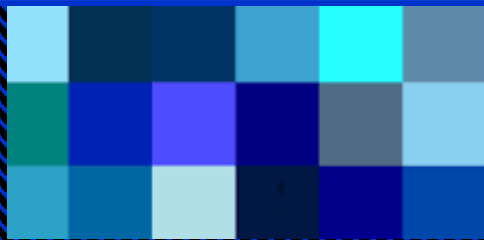

## Literacy

Texts — Rainbow Fish, Finding Nemo, The Snail and The Whale, Sharing a Shell, The Storm Whale

Phonics— review sounds ai—er. Review tricky words is—sure.

Innovate a story using a story map, reread familiar stories, orally tell a story in their own words using recently learnt vocabulary.

## Maths

Doubling and halving, number bonds with numbers within 10, odd and even numbers

Addition and subtraction within 10: recognition, representation, ordering, problem solving

Counting beyond 20 and recognising the pattern of numbers

Pattern focusing on AB/ABA/ABB/ABC

Capacity—use the language related to capacity

## Understanding the World

Forest Schools sessions weekly, explore the natural world, begin to understand the negative impact humans can have on the environment and what we can do to help.

Looking at similarities and differences— Floating and Sinking, Spring talking about seasons and signs of Spring —what's changed?
